The project aims to promote equity, anti-discrimination, and inclusion in language education through increasing accessibility and universal design in education, with a focus on learners with special educational needs. The project responds to the needs of the academic and school community. The aim of the SCALED project is to compile [a report on good practices](#) and [a methodological guide](#) as well as design an [online course](#) on inclusive education, universal design for learning, differentiated instruction and methods of increasing accessibility of the teaching process.

The course will be part of the initial training and continuing professional development of pre-service and in-service foreign language school- teachers and academic teachers.

The course will equip teachers with tools to eliminate barriers and effectively include all students in the language education process. Long-term benefits include equalizing educational opportunities and significantly improving the well-being of people learning foreign languages and learning content through a foreign language.
